One Wednesday evening, not too long ago, I was walking into the Sanctuary listening to Doug playing “Take Me Out to the Ball Game”. The mental images of being on vacation, frying brats, and listening to Bob Uecker were dancing in my head. The Council went through a detailed process of discerning who we thought would be ideal cross-sectional candidates for being on this 5 to 7 person Profile Development Team. Unfortunately, the early results of our search has not yielded much fruit.

Our Profile Development Team must thoughtful and a diverse cross-section of age, gender, and longevity. This team is an important way for our family to become involved in setting our future. And if “Our Future is Now” and “Gloria Dei is Worth Saving”, we truly need those people who Karen approaches to say “Yes” if at all possible. If Karen



Gloria Dei Worship and Liturgy Meeting Minutes

June 10th , 2019

Meeting was opened with a prayer lead by Raeline.

Dave gave Directory of Ministry Report: Next Quarterly Huddle will be July 7th. Raeline will put together some bullet points, Dave will add them to the Power Point and Barb will give the report during the service. Dave is planning a Wednesday Evening Service around the fire pit the week of VBC. It was well attended and enjoyed last year. Dave also requested Pastor Jim to revisit all the "inactive" members on the roles. The council will determine what the protocol will be to have members reinstated once they are inactive. Currently the by-laws state that members must attend one service and donate time, talent or financially at least once per calendar year to remain active. However, we do not have any procedures to reinstate. We held a new member reception just this past Sunday. We anticipate that we will have another new member reception sometime in July. Date to be determined. Dave will be on vacation June 22 through June 29th and Aug. 10th through August 17th. Jim will lead all the services during these times, however Aug. 11th there will be no service due to the ecumenical service being held at the Kiel park. A discussion was held regarding whether we should decline the request to host the ecumenical service at Gloria Dei on Good Friday 2020. Shall we wait until we have a settled Pastor or do we go ahead and agree to host? Final decision will be made by Council. Lastly Dave reported that he has set up 3 bulletin templates for Ann to use. We should not have any concerns in getting the bulletins ready and printed while Dave is on vacation. Ann just needs to copy and paste from Sunday and Seasons.

Barb reported that she had talked with recent Confirmands about participating as Worship Assistants or joining some committees. One request that came out of the conversation is that at least one younger member of our congregation would like us to hold a "Rock Service". We have had contemporary services in the past.
