The Gospel according to St. Luke, the 17th Chapter

⁵The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith!" ⁶The Lord replied, "If you had faith the size of a mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you.

⁷"Who among you would say to your slave who has just come in from plowing or tending sheep in the field, 'Come here at once and take your place at the table'? ⁸Would you not rather say to him, 'Prepare supper for me, put on your apron and serve me while I eat and drink; later you may eat and drink'? ⁹Do you thank the slave for doing what was commanded? ¹⁰So you also, when you have done all that you were ordered to do, say, 'We are worthless slaves; we have done only what we ought to have done!'"

I've been listening to a few whispers floating around the congregation and I thought it would be prudent to address a few generic topics that may hopefully reground ourselves a bit.

There is no doubt that Gloria Dei is making some excellent strides moving forward. As I mentioned at the last Quarterly Information Huddle, we should feel good about how things are beginning to turn around. While our progress remains a bit fragile, an increase in ministry and outreach is evident. I submit that anyone who says that Gloria Dei is hurting and won't survive hasn't been here in quite a while. Point 1 – look around the congregation and observe who hasn't been here in a while. Take the initiative and reach out to our members who haven't been here in a while or have been moved to the inactive role. Pastor Jim does regularly reach out to inactive members, but I submit, the best source of convincing a member to return are friends and neighbors.

I hope you read the Gospel lesson above. It shows that God expects us to do our jobs in service to others. Look to those who are hurting, whether they are in our congregation or not. Listen to them. Help them. Care for them. That all equals 'Loving Them'. This brings me to <u>Point 2 – we all have responsibilities for God's Kingdom here on Earth</u>. And sometimes we may not get the recognition 'we feel – we deserve'. Our Gospel reminds us that we are to be like slaves, in service to one another. Notice the story, the master wants to be taken care of first, before the slave takes care of himself – and this is most likely done without fanfare or accolades. What do we do for the church, for ministry, for outreach? Do we only do things that bring us recognition? Or do we focus on getting the job done – and if we happen to get recognized; great! If not, oh well <smile>, the job still needs to be done.

Whether we're in school or at work or even among friends, or even in our families, when we do something positive, we like to be recognized for it, right? Sure we do! It's normal – it's natural. We like to feel appreciated – it makes us feel good – it gives us new energy to go out and do more. Maybe in a way, when we get recognized, it's like someone planting an energy seed inside of us.

Consider when we go to another person and tell them – thank you – job well done – you are appreciated. <u>Point 3 – Please take time to try to recognize the work that is done by others, for those words or some sort of symbolic thank you, could uplift the spirit of someone who's having a not so good type day.</u>

Some call this being a friend. Some might call this ministry. Jesus tells us to do this. Jesus tells us to lift up others. Whatever you want to call it, it's something that each of can very easily do and doesn't cost a dime.

Who have we (individually or collectively) reached out to recently to show appreciation? Perhaps this month you may want to reach out to our new neighbors, the Pentecostals of New Holstein. Have you noticed the front windows how clean they are? Have you noticed that the kitchen floor has been cleaned, with the smell of 'cleanliness' permeating throughout the church? Have you noticed that all the pew cushions were vacuumed? Perhaps, individuals could reach out in neighborly love and appreciate the work being done for us? Lastly, I don't want our own congregational members to go unnoticed either. We do have faithful members who help with trash collection, flowerbed maintenance, vacuuming, and other routine chores as well (who don't take time to sign the clean-up sign-up list). I would like to say thank you to each and everyone one of you who prefer to be nameless. You are noticed and appreciated. Acts, such as these, help save Gloria Dei from incurring additional expenses in our budget.




