A Thanksgiving thought...along with some others

"Now thank we all our God" is a hymn we know...but do we know its origin? It was written by a German Pastor, Marin Rinkhart, in the 17<sup>th</sup> century. The 30 Years War was ongoing and the Bubonic Plague was ravaging much of Europe.

Rinkhart was conducting 40-50 funerals a day; a total of more than 4,480. Included in this number were many children, friends. And his wife. It was a terrible time for him.

Yet in the midst of all this, Rinkhart found God's blessings to be real. He had an abiding trust in and gratitude for God's presence. He wrote "Now thank we all our God... who wondrous things has done", in the midst of his personal loss.

This year our special national day of thanksgiving will be different due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. Family gatherings may not be the "normal" kind. We might wonder what is there to be thankful for.

If we have this question let all of us remember Rinkhart's words of thanksgiving "with countless gifts of love, and still is ours today!" Have a joyous thanksgiving!

Gloria Dei's COVID 19 Task Force (Michael Hetzner, Barb Spiegel, Coleen Allee, Julie Schaefer) is preparing an additional policy and procedures for return to worship, for Council to act on at its November's meeting. This includes a covenant and procedure for safe behavior entering, attending, and leaving indoor events which we will ask everyone to read and agree to before coming, procedures for keeping the building clean, and supplies to be provided including masks and cleaning supplies. The Task Force is monitoring COVID 19 data and coordinating with local health departments and ELCA to determine a recommended date for safe return to indoor worship, possibly later in September or October. Online and parking lot services will continue as weather permits as an option for anyone unable to attend indoors due to their health or personal preference.

Any members of Gloria Dei who wish to provide input regarding safe return to indoor worship are encouraged to contact any of the Task Force members.
