Let us again celebrate with joy the birth of the Christ Child for no one else, nothing else would do.


Have a joyous Christmas for even now "God is with us"!

Adjourn/Prayer Motion Nealey, second Julie to adjourn. Motion carried.



#### Celebrate the Blessings of Gloria Dei


As we celebrate the blessings of the Christmas seasons, let's also share those blessings with our community.
