The Season Of Lent

The Lenten Season begins with Ash Wednesday, February 17, 2021. It is during this time of 40 days that we, the church, remember Jesus' walk of faith to the Cross on Golgotha.

On Ash Wednesday we mark our foreheads with ashes to acknowledge that "we are dust and to dust we shall return'. The life – giving cross marked by the ashes serves to remind us of Jesus' death on the cross which brings us God's forgiveness and his eternal life-giving resurrection from the tomb on Easter.

At Gloria Dei we will observe lent in the following ways:

Ash Wednesday, February 17, 2021 at 6:30 PM: as special liturgy/service of Penance will take place. Holy Communion will be celebrated. For those who wish the imposition of ashes on their forehead will take place. Worship will be available VIA live streaming on Facebook – Parking Lot and in person for a limited number. Additional information will be shared in the future.

Sundays in Lent: Worship will begin with a Lenten Litany: Remember the Dust (this includes verses of O Sacred Head and Responsive Readings) Holy Communion celebrated – virtual worship format.

Lenten Mid-Week Wednesdays at 6:30 PM: A theme (yet to be scheduled) will be our focus on Wednesdays. We will worship (possibly) VIA Zoom. In person numbers will be limited. This will begin the week after Ash Wednesday.

We Journey through Lent knowing we have been reconciled with God though Christ. We rejoice knowing that "now's the day of salvation".

During Lent let us make the connection between: the manger of Bethlehem – the cross of Good Friday – the empty tomb victory of Easter". He is not here, he has risen".

Gloria Dei limited in person worship. Following the guidelines set out by our Return to Worship Task Force that was approved by council, the following procedures will apply:
