At the annual meeting, Gloria Dei passed a budget that projected a shortfall for 2021. This report is intended to keep the congregation informed on overall budget on a monthly basis. Please reach out to me if you have any specific questions.

For expenses, January contained several quarterly bills and two yearly bills which increased the monthly expenses. February contained only the usual monthly bills.

For income, February had an increase in offering revenue compared to the general average. The income also includes the rent from the Pentacostals and \$284 received from Thrivent Choice.

There was discussion about communication to congregation about giving vs. offering income in a simplified manner in addition to the detailed report that is included in the council meeting minutes. Ideas to be brought forward next month.

Extension of Pastor's Contract. Pastor Harswick accepted an interim position on Washington Island **Continued From page 3** and his last Sunday at Gloria Dei will be April 25th. He will officiate a wedding at Gloria Dei in May. Council will reach out to Jim Liddle to see if he is available on an intentional supply pastor basis. We have heard from the Synod and there is a shortage of interim pastors; council is in contact with them to determine next steps.

Confirmation Sunday will occur before Pastor Harswick leaves. Conversation about first communion will be initiated by David Hoban with Pastor Harswick to see if that is something that could still be fit before the end of pastor's contract.

April 10 – Green Bay Conference will be held virtually. Need a volunteer.

May 14-15 – Synod Assembly will be held virtually. May 14 4:30-8:00 Workshops and May 15 8:30-5 meeting.

Installation of new bishop will be on Sunday April 10 at 10:30 and attendance will be virtual.

Broderick and Rachel Barrett requested a transfer to Christ Lutheran Church in Menominee. Council approved unanimously.

Old Business

Review of Back to Worship—As of March 28, Palm Sunday, council unanimously approved to allow 25 people in church at one time to worship. Masks are required and social distancing rules will continue to be followed. This will extend to the Pentecostal Church that shares our facility.

Land Inquiry— Task force obtained the drawings of the property and discovered that part of the septic system drain bed was in the prairie land. No further contact from the interested party at this time.

New Business-

Conversation about Grants – Jennifer brought a resource book with available grants within the state. She volunteered to see what grants might be available to Gloria Dei and offered to help write the request when council provides some ideas that could be applicable. Council to provide some ideas of projects that could use grant money.

Conversation to remind congregation about using Thrivent Choice dollars and to buy SCRIP as household budget friendly ways to assist Gloria Dei.

Building update – property team will get some quotes for how much it would cost to stain the exterior of the building and then develop a proposal on how to proceed this summer to move the staining project forward again.

Calendar update. See the Pastor report for Holy Week schedule. Bible Study is on Wednesday morning at 6:30am.

We agreed to continue Council meetings monthly on the second Tuesday at 6 pm. Next meeting April 13, 2021

The meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer after a motion by Bryce and second by Brenda.

Thoughts on Stewardship by Jerry Jensen

In this time of rapid change, sometimes I wonder what it is all about. Wearing masks in public, social distancing, stimulus checks, and sanitizing everything. In rummaging through my work desk I discovered an article in Giving magazine by Sondra Wheeler dated 2002. (That was pre-COVID days). In the article titled "The Economics of Fearlessness", A Celebration of Grace, she opens the text with a consideration what the real gospel could make in our public treatment of possessions if we lived as if the things we profess were true.
