5. Youth/Christian Education (David)—Ann will discuss with David and Pastor Jim plans for Confirmation Class and First Communion.

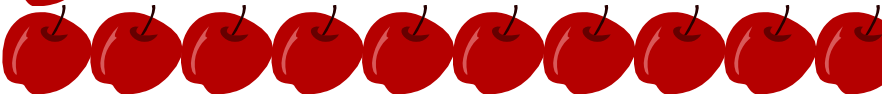
Dear Church Members of Gloria Dei,
