If you or your child is **entering seventh or eighth grade** this year and would like to join Gloria Dei Church, or if you are an older teen



- 5. Youth/Christian Education (David)—Ann will discuss with David and Pastor Jim plans for Confirmation Class and First Communion.


#### Calendar Update
