Current Covid Precautions Policy: Masking is voluntary. Side pews are marked off for optional social distancing. We take communion in the pews individually and share the peace at a distance.





For May, the general income was \$1,319 more than general expenses. Year to date, income exceeds expenses by \$7,010. May expenses were nearly the absolute minimum that they could be. Note that our pastoral expenses have raised slightly with the addition of Wednesday night services through summer.

Through 5 months, the finances are close to that values predicted by the budget.

Thank you from the Salvation Army for 29 lbs of items for the food pantry. Demand/need is on the rise. Dates and times have yet to be decided but might be offered after Wednesday services. Ideas for advertising were discussed. Motion approved (Larson, Lecker). Mike Hetzner is recruiting members for the Divine Time Players to provide short 10-20 minute plays at Wednesday night services. Contact Mike Hetzner if interested.
