For June, the general income was \$285 shorter than general expenses. Year to date, income exceeds expenses by \$6,600. June expenses included the quarterly \$222 for our banking software and \$195 for mowing. Through half the year, the finances are close to that values predicted by the budget with our current pastor ministry.

President’s Report—Thank you to Nealey Janicek for providing flowers on Mother’s Day and Dad’s Root Beer on Father’s Day. Pastor Jim will not be able to offer Financial Peace University due to cost. Three students will take confirmation classes on Wednesdays from 5:30-6:30 PM. It is council responsibility to arrange for supply pastors. Hetzner will contact Jim Herschleb to provide services on August 7 & 10. If not available, bible study members will do Wednesday service while Hetzner volunteered to do Sunday service. Sunday service will continue to be available on Facebook live as services have had anywhere between 18-87 views this year.

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Health Precautions Update—Risk is low at this time. No changes needed.

Call Committee Update—1. Bishop Asher will be contacted to update our ministry profile to part-time. 2. We will not partner with St. Luke’s at this time. 3. We will investigate the possibility of sharing a parttime pastor with Faith Lutheran Church in Valders. 4. Bishop Asher will also contact a candidate to let them know that we are interested in a part-time pastor.—Lecker, Salzsieder
