For September, the general income was approximately \$1,500 more than general expenses. Year to date, income exceeds expenses by \$7,194.

September expenses included \$222 for the quarter banking software fee, \$115 bi-yearly anti-virus protection for the office computer, \$173 on bathroom towels, and \$390 for lawn mowing services.

The food drive on 9/11 raised \$710 in addition to the food donated but was not paid out before the end of the month. There was also \$25 donated to the Memorial Fund.

President's Report—The Gideon Organization would like to speak at a future service. Council decided not to pursue at this time. Pastor Hartwick requested transfer out of GDLC. —Larson, Sellen

Health Precautions Update—COVID is at low risk in Calumet County. Third booster is available. No changes are recommended at this time.

Call Committee Update—Hoban has been in contact with Pastor Asher. Bio information has been updated with synod. A copy of our church bio is posted in the narthex for members to see/read/give input. Contact Hoban with any comments. There are no candidates available for a part-time position at this time. We will continue to plan a budget that can support a part-time pastor's salary. We will be proactive in our planning and include Holy Closure if we don't find a solution or candidate in the future.

Committees & Reports

- 1) Fellowship/Outreach—The Pancake Breakfast was an enjoyable fellowship time. Discussion was held on having more gatherings like this but tweaked so children involved with preparing breakfast could be in church during service and also attend Sunday School. Also discussed How do we get families with children to participate again? The use and effectiveness of the Calling Tree was discussed.
- 2) Property—Water samples are all good and will continue practices to keep it that way. Craig Heller will fell a dying tree on the south side of the property. Fans need to be shut off after use of the sanctuary and building. A date will be determined for shed clean-out to coincide with New Holstein bulk pick-up. A motion to approve GDLC and Pentecostal members painting the narthex for \$300 or less was made. —Larson, Kobs
- 3) Stewardship/ILong Range Planning—No report. A date for Stewardship Sunday is still to be decided.
- 4) Worship/Music—Schedule for remainder of the year: Sunday Service at 8:00AM (Traditional) and Wednesday Service at 7:00PM (Bible Study). Sunday Facebook services will continue, but we would appreciate more volunteers. Thank you to Cary Johanes for leading worship on Sunday, October 9th and to Nealey Janicek for sharing her Lay Ministry journey. We also thank Coleen Allee for Children's Time with her great lead-in to our Sunday Pancake Breakfast. Discussion was held on returning to Sharing the Peace, standing for the Gospel, and communion at altar in the future
