For October, the general income was approximately \$776 less than general expenses. October expenses included \$778 for quarter taxes, \$600 for pastorial coverage for September, \$259 yearly subscription to Sundays and Seasons for worship materials, and \$92 yearly fire inspection. October income includes \$225 from the craft fair, \$908 from the rummage sale and \$452 found at highway cleanup.

Year to date income is \$5,269 more than expenses but includes \$7,000 transferred from the dinner theater.

Directory of Ministry Report—We have Pastor Ralph Hankermeyer scheduled until the end of January. Our church record book of membership, baptisms, weddings, confirmations, funerals, etc. has not been updated since 2017. This is a project that will be worked on by Nealey Janicek and inputted into IconCMO's Church Management Denominational Software. Information about <u>Holy Conversations</u> can be found on the ELCA website. Lay leadership may be the future of many congregations.
