# **Director of Ministry Report February 2024**



Along with the changing weather, we are about to enter a new season in the church year. Lent is almost here. Ash Wednesday is February 14 this year. Look for more information about that service in the next few days. We will also have Wednesday evening services through lent, in addition to our regular Sunday services. Again, more info will be coming soon. As we enter into this season of preparation, let's also take time to prepare our hearts for the message of Christ's resurrection. I'm sure we are all familiar with 'giving up something' for lent. I remember as a kid I would give up candy, or TV. It's a little trickier as an adult, though I could certainly benefit from giving up a few things. Instead of that, I like to focus on adding things. I'll add in an extra devotion each day or week. For December, the general income was approximately \$2,872 less than general expenses.

December pastoral expenses were \$3,530. This is an increase due to three Advent services, a Christmas Eve service and a fifth Sunday in the month. Other December expenses were \$201 quarter payment for banking software, \$207 yearly refuse bill, \$917 yearly workers compensation insurance and approximately \$200 in various supplies (filters, soap, TP, etc). December income includes \$60 for rummage sale and \$700 for special offerings (Advent, Christmas).

2023 income was \$1,233 more than expenses but includes \$7,000 transferred from the dinner theater and \$1,534 transferred from Vacation Bible Camp. The final 2023 financial report will be included with the annual meeting.

**Directory of Ministry Report**—Still in communication with St. Luke's & Synods & candidate. We have coverage with Pastor Ralph Hankermeyer until the end of January. February 4 is covered. Pastor Ralph will be available in the following weeks.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

1) Fellowship/Outreach—Socks will be next for the Mitten Tree! Gloria's Meals on January 31, 5-6PM will be chicken tetrazzini. The Chili Cookoff will be February 4 at noon – get ready for some wild recipes!
